Although **South Carolina has the third highest DUI death rate** in the nation, it's also our state with the most progress in reducing DUIs with a **4.6 percent year-over-year reduction**.

North Carolina was ranked fourth in DUI fatalities followed by **Georgia with the fifth most DUI fatalities** in the nation.

2nd South Carolina – 9.17

3rd Georgia – 7.04

4th Virginia – 5.35
